## **Patrol investigating a plane crash in Ottawa County, at least 4 dead**

PORT CLINTON – The Ohio State Highway Patrol is investigating fatal plane crash that occurred at approximately 12:52 p.m. today that killed at least four people. A 340 Cessna airplane crashed into a backyard of a home located on Port Clinton Eastern Road, west of State Route 269, in Ottawa County, in Danbury Township.

A representative from the Federal Aviation Administration is on-scene and the National Transportation Safety Board has been notified and is en-route. The Ottawa County Sheriff's office and the Dansbury Township Police Department are also on-scene.

More information will be released once next-of-kin notifications have been made.
