### **Akron woman arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Lebanon Correctional Institution**

LEBANON – An Akron woman will appear in Lebanon Municipal Court today after Ohio State Highway Patrol troopers arrested her on Tuesday for attempting to convey drugs into the Lebanon Correctional Institution.

Troopers charged Kaijeana C. Bailey, 28, with attempting to convey drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony; possession of criminal tools, a fifth-degree felony; and obstructing official business, a second-degree misdemeanor.

Troopers and Department of Rehabilitation and Correction investigators obtained information that Bailey would convey drugs to her husband during a scheduled visit. Bailey was arrested after being served with a search warrant and a subsequent search of her person revealed 11 balloons containing five grams of marijuana.

Bailey was incarcerated in the Warren County Jail. If convicted, she could face up to five years in prison and a \$13,250 fine.
