Cincinnati woman arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Lebanon Correctional Institution

LEBANON - A Cincinnati woman appeared in Lebanon Municipal Court yesterday after Ohio State Highway Patrol troopers arrested her Monday for attempting to convey drugs into the Lebanon Correctional Institution.

Troopers charged Margaret Walsh, 48, with attempting to convey drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony, and possession of criminal tools, a fifth-degree felony.

Troopers and Department of Rehabilitation and Correction Investigators obtained information that Walsh would be attempting to convey drugs to her husband, an inmate, during their scheduled visit. Walsh was caught with 8 balloons concealed in her bra. The balloons each contained a small amount of marijuana.

Walsh was incarcerated in the Warren County Jail. If convicted, she could face up to seven years in prison and a \$15,000 fine.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol investigates criminal activity on state-owned and leased property.
