Lindsay M. Komlanc Named Patrol Spokesperson

COLUMBUS - Ohio State Highway Patrol Superintendent Col. David W. Dicken today announced his appointment of Lindsay M. Komlanc to serve as Patrol spokesperson.

Komlanc currently serves as Media Relations Director for the Department of Public Safety, acting as spokesperson for the Department's divisions which include the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Ohio Homeland Security, the Ohio Investigative Unit, the Emergency Management Agency, Emergency Medical Services, the Office of Criminal Justice Services, and the Ohio Traffic Safety Office.

In addition to her duties with the Patrol, she will continue to coordinate the media relations efforts of the Department's eight divisions.

Lt. Anthony C. Bradshaw, who has served as Public Affairs Commander and Patrol spokesperson since July 2006, will transition to a new assignment within the Patrol's General Headquarters.

Komlanc joined the Ohio Department of Public Safety in August, 2007. She previously worked for the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), where she coordinated statewide communications and served as the Public Information Officer for ODOT's District 6 Office and Franklin County, beginning in 2002.

She is a graduate of Ohio University's E.W. Scripps School of Journalism.
