### **ID's released of those involved in head-on collision on Interstate 70**

ZANESVILLE - The Zanesville Post of the Ohio State Highway Patrol is continuing their investigation of a two-vehicle head-on collision that occurred at approximately 12:57 p.m. today in the eastbound lanes of Interstate 70 near milepost 147 in Muskingum County.

A blue 2000 Chevy Cavalier two-door traveling in the westbound lanes crossed the median, rotated counter-clockwise, and struck a white 2006 Dodge Caravan traveling eastbound. The driver of the Chevy, Tiffany L. Irwin, 23, and passengers; her daughter, Ava Nessline, 7 months-old and son, Dallas G. Wickham, 3, all of Zanesville; mother, Maria M. Barnhill, 41, of Columbus; and uncle, Scott T. Skeens, 39, of Philo, were pronounced dead at the scene.

The driver of the Dodge, Anna Geist, 39, of Waldorf, Md. is in serious condition and has been transported to Grant Medical Center in Columbus. Her young child passenger was uninjured.

The crash is still under investigation.
