Investigation Continues into State Route 60 Bus Fatality

(ZANESVILLE) – Ohio State Highway Patrol Motor Vehicle inspectors have completed a thorough inspection of the school bus and found no mechanical issues that may have contributed to the crash involving a Tri-Valley Local School bus on June 2, 2010.

Troopers from the Patrol's crash reconstruction unit inspected and analyzed the interior of the bus. Patrol's photographic services unit also took detailed photographs of the interior.

The electronic control module from the bus was analyzed, and no defects were recorded. The on-board video from the bus continues to be analyzed by the Patrol's forensic computer unit.

This crash remains under investigation.
