


### SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSIONS

11/10/2008 – 11/23/2008

Trooper Smart	Trooper Smart stopped a 2004 Ford F150 with AZ plates on I70 for a speed violation. Numerous criminal indicators and a K9 alert by Rita led to a PC search that uncovered 1/2 kilo of cocaine (~\$500,000) in luggage in the bed of the truck. Further, Trooper Smart put out a BOLO alert for a suspect Suburban with CO plates that appeared to be traveling with the F150. Columbus PD officers spotted the second vehicle and made a traffic stop for a speed violation. A K9 alert on the Suburban led to a PC search that uncovered 325 lbs. of marijuana (\$741,000). The drivers of the vehicles were later found out to be father and son. Columbus PD and DEA are handling the cases.

Trooper Baranowski	Post 89 received an APR alert for a stolen 2003 Chevy 3500 van with CA plates from an ELSAG camera on the Westgate interchange of the Ohio Turnpike. Inside the van, a total of 12 illegal immigrants were found. Occupants were detained and Federal Immigration was contacted.



### OSHP DRUG ARRESTS

- OSHP Troopers made 4,453 drug arrests so far this year (Jan-Oct 2008). This is 505 more drug arrests than in Jan-Oct 2007 and 168 more than in Jan-Oct 2006 (+13% and +4% respectively).
- From Jan-Oct 2008, OSHP District 9 Troopers have recorded the most drug arrests (755).
- At the County-level, the largest number of drug arrests occurred in Stark (179), followed by Franklin (175), Scioto (169), Summit (143), and Butler (130). Overall, nearly one in five OSHP drug arrests occurred in one of these five counties during Jan-Oct 2008 (796 or 18%).
- OSHP Troopers were involved in 565 drug arrests in May, the most of any month during Jan-Oct 2008. In fact, the two highest single days for OSHP drug arrests occurred during Memorial Day weekend (45 each on Friday, May 23 and Saturday, May 24).
