





Year-To-Date = 899





WEEKLY FOCUS: Jan. – Sep. 2006 Fatal Crash Picture

- Provisional data indicate that **895 traffic fatalities (816 crashes)** occurred on Ohio roads January-September 2006. Forty-two percent of fatalities resulted from **single-unit** crashes.
- There were 279 **alcohol-related** traffic fatalities - 31% of January through September 2006 traffic fatalities.
- Fifty-four percent of January-September 2006 traffic fatalities were **unbelted**.
- Thirty-five percent (35%) of Ohio traffic fatalities in January – September 2006 were **speed-related**.
- Of the total fatalities, 123 (14%) involved **commercial** vehicles.
- There were 128 reported **motorcycle** fatalities during the first three quarters of 2006.
