



## REPORTED FATAL CRASHES INVOLVING COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, 01/01/2005-10/31/2005



### **WEEKLY FOCUS: COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**

- From 01/01/2005-10/31/2005, there were 136 commercial-involved fatal traffic crashes in Ohio.
- The top counties for commercial-involved fatal crashes include: Cuyahoga (7); Hamilton (7); Seneca (6); Franklin (5); Lucas (5); and Stark (5).
- OSHP was the lead investigating agency in 88 crashes (65%), followed by city PD (32), and sheriffs' offices (16).
- The top causes for commercial-involved fatal crashes (01/01/05-10/31/05) include: Failure to Yield/Running Red Light or Stop Sign (28%); Driving Left of Center (13%); Following Too Closely (12%); and Improper Lane Change (10%).
