




- ▲ Triple Fatality Crash (1)





January-June 2007 Reported Ohio Traffic Fatalities

- Provisional data indicate that **538 traffic fatalities (496 crashes)** occurred on Ohio roads in January – June 2007 (*there were 554 reported fatalities from January – June 2006*).
- Twenty-eight percent of January – June 2007 traffic fatalities were related to **impaired** driving (*compared to 31% reported from January – June 2006*).
- Over half (55%) of January – June 2007 traffic fatalities were **unbelted** (*compared to 60% reported from January – June 2006*).
- Forty percent of reported Ohio traffic fatalities from January – June 2007 were **speed-related** (*compared to 29% reported in the first quarter of 2006*).
- Fifteen percent (83) of January – June 2007 traffic fatalities resulted from crashes involving **commercial** vehicles (*compared to 16% reported from January – June 2006*).
- Fifty-nine **motorcycle** fatalities were reported in the first quarter of 2007 (*there were 64 reported from January – June 2006*).
- Fatal crashes in urban areas increased by 13% in January – June 2007, compared to the same time period in 2006 – in spite of suspected underreporting in Cuyahoga County.
