




- ▲ Triple Fatality Crash (1)





January-March 2007 Reported Ohio Traffic Fatalities

- Provisional data indicate that **242 traffic fatalities (224 crashes)** occurred on Ohio roads in January – March 2007 (there were 246 reported fatalities at the close of the first quarter in 2006).
- Thirty-one percent of the fatalities resulted from **single-unit** crashes (compared to 30% reported in the first quarter of 2006).
- Twenty-five percent of first quarter traffic fatalities were related to **impaired** driving (compared to 24% reported in the first quarter of 2006).
- Just under half (49%) of January – March 2007 traffic fatalities were **unbelted** (compared to 40% reported in the first quarter of 2006).
- Thirty-seven percent of reported Ohio traffic fatalities from January – March 2007 were **speed-related** (compared to 28% reported in the first quarter of 2006).
- Fifteen percent (35) of first quarter 2007 fatalities resulted from crashes involving **commercial** vehicles (same proportion as reported in the first quarter of 2006).
- Seven **motorcycle** fatalities were reported in the first quarter of 2007 (1 more than last year).
